RULES & REGULATIONS

The committee of GSJC will not accept liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness caused to horses, riders, spectators or any other person or person's property.

- **Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times, competitors may be asked to leave if dogs are running around loose. Dog fights have occurred in the past and we would like to avoid this in the future.**
- The GSJC reserves the right to change, delete or alter the running of the show.
- Entries will be taken by entering on Global Entries www.globalentriesonline.com.au
- **NO LATE ENTRIES.**
- Membership privileges apply only to the rider, who must be a financial GSJC member. Membership entitles you to reduced clinic costs and opportunity for training days.
- You may become a financial member by downloading a membership form from our website www.geelongshowjumping.com.au and mailing it with the appropriate monies.
- **All competitors must be EV registered or GSJC members. Pony Club or Adult Riding Club Membership insurance doesn't cover our event for EV insurance.**
- **GSJC MEMBERSHIP:** Single: \$25.00 / Family: \$40.00 (children must be 18yrs & under) from the one family, Parents/Guardians and children.
- Membership year is 1st August 2011 to 31st July 2012.
- **Scratchings** – 75% of entry fee will be refunded if veterinary or medical certificate is produced.
- EV competitors summer dress code. All other competitors to be in their club's uniform or neat attire if you don't belong to a club.
- **Horses can only jump 2 height classes per day.**
- Competitors **can't** enter both **4A & 4B** on the same horse.
- Competitors **can't** enter both **Rescue Relays** on the same horse.
- **Freshman's** showjumping maximum of **3** rounds per horse.
- Medical Levy charge is paid to Global First Aid \$5.00 per rider
- Facility Fee charge is paid to Friends of Lake Lorne Reserve (FOLLR) for up keep to the grounds \$3.00 per horse.
- Camping fees - \$20.00 per vehicle for the entire event.
- Horse Yards \$5.00 per night, Pony Yards \$3.00 per night – Limited numbers
- Please note as of 1st January 2010, Equestrian Australia rule states all horses that are camping on grounds need to be in steel hard yards.

AM7 – Art. 245 Pt.3 – AM7 consists of 1 round and a Jump Off. Jump Off to immediately follow 1st round. If 1st round clear, bell will be rung to commence jump off round. Jump Off course needs to be learnt when walking the course. Jump Off course will be on the course plan posted near the entry gate. Jump Off rounds are against the clock.

AM5 – Art. 238 Pt.2.2 – AM5 consists of 1 round and a Jump Off. The Jump Off is run once all riders have jumped their 1st round and only the riders that have jumped clear can return into the 2nd round Jump Off.

For AM5 Jump Offs heights will go up and rounds are against the clock.

You can't enter both Rescue Relay classes on the same horse

Rescue Relay – 1. Two riders compete together in this class
2. The idea is to complete 2 rounds of the course, shared.
3. Speed Class

Rules:

1. When the bell starts the first rider only needs to go through the starting flags.
2. However on the completion of the 2 rounds both riders need to go through the finishing flags.
3. If one rider pulls a rail, then the other rider waiting must continue at the next fence.
4. If one rider has a stop, then the other rider waiting must take over and jump the same fence that they stopped at.
5. Riders may change at any time during the course. For example rider one jumps 1 & 2, rider two jumps 3 & 4, then rider one jumps 5, rider two jumps 6...

A plan's great but remember that when penalties occur riders must change straight away or elimination will occur.

Extra Info:

If rider one stops at fence 4, rider two must take over at fence 4 but if they also stop at fence 4, rider one must reattempt fence 4.

For all 5 Bar and 4 Bar classes you are only allowed to enter either classes on the same horse, you can't enter a 5 Bar and a 4 Bar class on the same horse.

Five Bar – Five bars are run over 5 rounds maximum, five jumps are placed in a straight line. Jumps rise over a round with the smallest at jump 1 and the largest at jump 5. If the rider clears all jumps, then they proceed onto the next round. Where the jumps are raised, this continues on until the last round has been completed or all riders have been knocked out of the competition. If in the case of equals, prize money will be split.

Four Bar – Four bars are run the same way as 5 Bars, run over a maximum of 5 rounds. With only four jumps in a straight line instead of 5. All other rules are the same.
